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





- To augment their communication skills.



Definition:
Specificity of analytical method is its ability to measure accurately an analyte in the presence of interference, such as synthetic precursors, excipients, enantiomers and know (or likely) degradation product that may be expected to be present in the sample matrix.
Discussion:
 > Specificity generally refers to a method that produces a response for a **single analyte** only.
 > **Selectivity** refers to a method which provides responses for a **Multiple chemical entities** that may/may not be distinguished from each other.
 > If each response is distinguished from all other responses, then the method is said to be selective.
 > Use of the term selectivity is appropriate for the methods based on chromatographic techniques like HPLC, UPLC and GC etc.
